



St George's Hill

The St George's Hill estate near Weybridge, one of the UK's most exclusive areas, has had access control and CCTV installed. It features the first use of new equipment by installers Mercury Security Systems and distributors ADI-GARDINER. The 400 residences grouped around a golf club have five closed roads, with entry to visitors via two manned gates. All roads are equipped with a **Survision CCTV system linked by Adpro transmission**, giving live streaming to a PC-based 24-hour central monitoring station. Survision can use standard cameras, and provides ANPR automatically to the operator, as a deterrent to intruders. Hertfordshire-based Mercury Director Michael Rothwell says: "Technically it is a very advanced system, involving commissioning by ourselves, on-site specialist from ADI, and Survision engineers, who came from France to help survey the site and produce the solution. With so many high-value residences across such a large tree filled area, cable transmission was ruled out in favour of phone lines, but we needed to obtain Microsoft support to ensure it was hacker-proof."
